Kennel Facility Inspection Form

General Requirements -

Applicants are required to have a facility for the care and housing of the dogs they typically exhibit. The area must provide a safe, secure, and sanitary environment and have suitable facilities for bathing and grooming. Appropriate climate control and ventilation must be provided given the geographic location of the facility.

The kennel must have suitable permanent inside and outside runs to appropriately accommodate the breeds and number of dogs the applicant typically handles. The runs must be secure and constructed large enough to provide adequate exercise area. The indoor runs must be of a size that allows the dog to maneuver and rest comfortably.

Crates used to transport dogs to and from shows in a vehicle, and later returned to a "kennel space", do not constitute a kennel for purposes of making application to the PHA. Crates left in a vehicle do not constitute a kennel for purposes of making application to the PHA.

Living quarters must be on the kennel property to provide 24-hour in-person supervision.

Transportation (kennel on the road) must be in a vehicle that is suitable, safe, and comfortable for the breed(s) being shown.

For both applicants and members, re-inspection of kennel facilities must be conducted upon a change of address.

<u>Leasing of a kennel facility</u> to satisfy application or membership requirements requires approval of the Board of Governors. The leased facility may be subject to inspection and must meet association requirements.
